## THE PRINCIPLES OF THE CLASSES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF NEUROLOGY

- 1. Classes start at 08:30 and end at 13:10.
- 2. Students are required to arrive to classes on time.

Being more than 15 minutes late will be treated as an absence by the assistant.

- 3. During classes, students are obliged to turn off or mute their mobile phones.
- 4. Classes consist of:
- a) seminars (seminar group),
- b) exercises (exercise groups).
- 5. A detailed schedule of classes is determined individually for each student group and is available on the information board of the Department of Neurology.
- 6. After each seminar and exercises, the student receives a stamp in the Individual Student Card confirming his/her attendance at the classes.
- 7. During the exercises, students, under the supervision of an assistant, acquire practical skills:
- a) at the patient's bedside neurological examination
- b) problem solving discussion with the active participation of students led by an assistant.
- 8. Students are required to prepare themselves for each day of classes based on the knowledge acquired in previous years of study and on the basis of textbooks, the list of which is included in the relevant syllabus.
- 9. Students are required to actively participate in seminars and exercises.
- 10. On the last day of the block of neurology classes, after practical assessment of the subject, the student is obliged to deliver to the secretary of the Department of Neurology an Individual Student Card, which will be the basis for passing the course and taking the final exam.
- 11. Clean medical clothing and medical shoes are required during classes at the Department of Neurology.
- 12. The student should have his own stethoscope and a neurological hammer (for rent at the secretary of the Department of Neurology)
- 13. During classes, the student is not allowed to leave the premises of the Department without the consent of the assistant.
- 14. The rules for making up and passing classes in the event of absence are agreed individually with the assistant conducting the given class.
- 15. Students are obliged to comply with the health and safety regulations in force during clinical classes, which they confirm with their own signature in the Individual Student Card on the first day of classes before the start of classes.

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
